

Can we live away from our real life? Is there a world where we can do anything we would like to? The movie *Ready Player One*, directed by Steven Spielberg, shows a world where these things can happen.



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

We all know that good health is very important for us. Then, how can you keep healthy? Do you often do exercise? Even if the answer is yes, it's not enough.

According to a new research done by an American scientist called Peter Katzmarzyk, people who want to live longer and healthier lives should not only exercise more, but also sit less.

Mr. Katzmarzyk is a scientist at the University of Louisiana. He has led a team to study how sitting all day influences the length of life. He said, "We sit while we're eating. We sit in the car. We sit while we are watching TV. And many of us sit for many hours at work. On average, Americans sit between four and five hours a day." Mr. Katzmarzyk added, "Even though you do exercise for half an hour every day, that doesn't mean you can sit for the rest of your waking hours."

The research shows that if one sits less than three hours a day, he might live longer by two years. Some companies have already realized the importance of sitting less. Change has already come to their offices, especially in the design (设计) of desks. A "standing desk" lets people stand when they work.

Another new design is called the "treadmill desk". A treadmill is an exercise machine that has a moving surface that people can walk or run on while remaining in the same place. Even some US schools are beginning to provide their students with desks that are bicycle parts to keep children moving in class.
